

Judy Wiant - Seminole County Council PTA President (2008 -2010)

Judy has been held many positions including president on elementary, middle, and high school's local PTA boards over her 25 years of active membership in PTA.

She has held the position of Region 5 Representative (being the Florida PTA representative for 7 counties) for over 5 years while also serving on the Council as the Internet Safety Chair. She has presented internet safety seminars for many of the PTAs in the county as well as a presenter at State PTA trainings. As the Seminole County Council President, she holds a position on the Florida State PTA board of directors.

She facilitated the Award winning '**Keys to Your Character**' Character Education program for Seminole County Public School for 10 years. Working with all 60+ schools in the district as well as organizing the first ever Character Education Conference in the state for 3 years, before joining forces with the University of Central Florida's Character Education and Social Responsibility efforts through a grant to sponsor 4 additional State Wide Character Education Conferences.

In 2008 she took on the position of Program Coordinator of the Student Museum and Center for the Social Studies for SCPS located in Sanford, FL. The Museum is one of the main field trip destinations for SCPS fourth grade students who are studying Florida history. Approximately 6,500 students tour the facility yearly.
